Materials

- worsted weight yarn (approx. 350 yards)
- size 8 knitting needles
- tapestry needle
- buttons (optional)

Gauge

4 stitches per inch in stockinette stitch

Abbreviations

- co - cast on
- k - knit
- p - purl
- st(s) - stitch(es)
- rep - repeat
- dec - decrease
- inc - increase

Instructions

Jacket

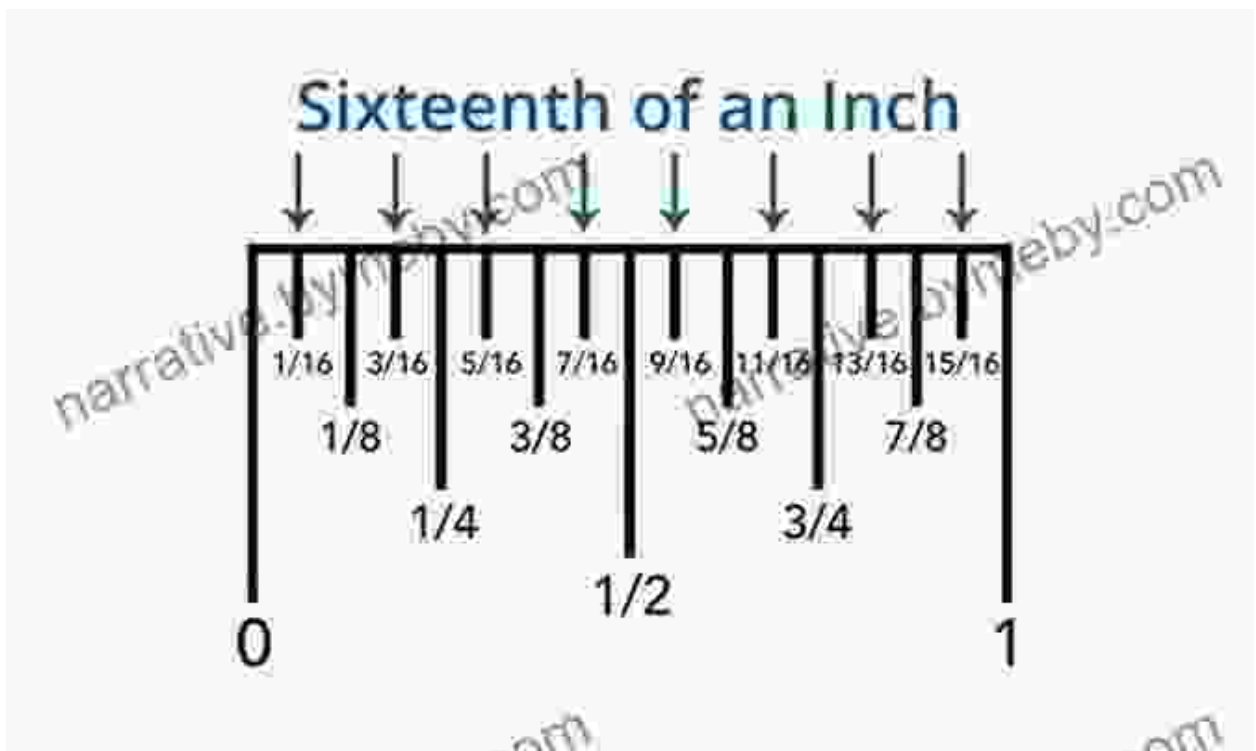
1. Co 60 sts.



2. K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.



3. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 6 inches from cast on edge.



4. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.



5. Continue knitting until piece measures 12 inches from cast on edge.



6. Shape shoulders: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows.



7. Bind off remaining sts.



Hat

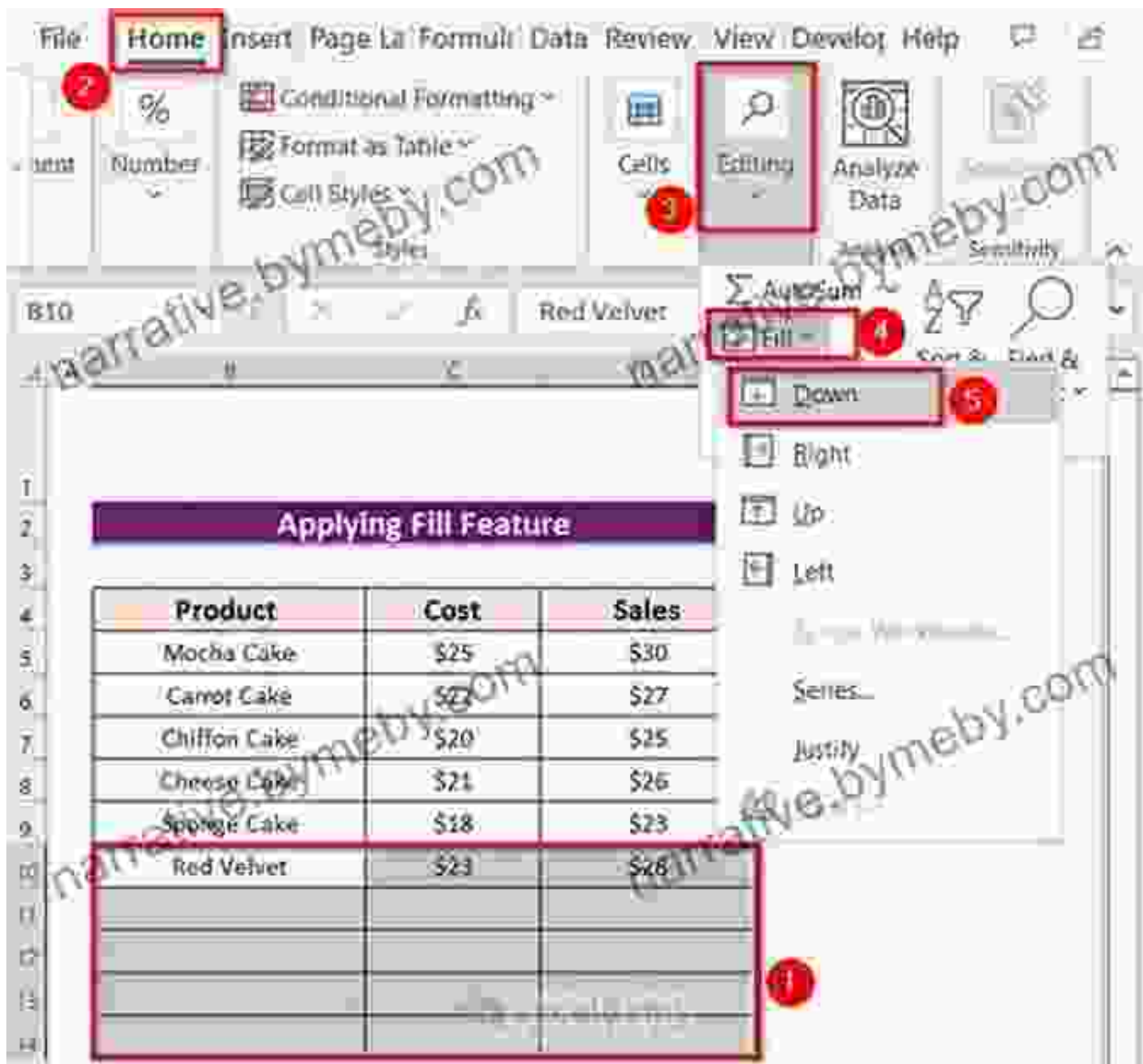
1. Co 80 sts.



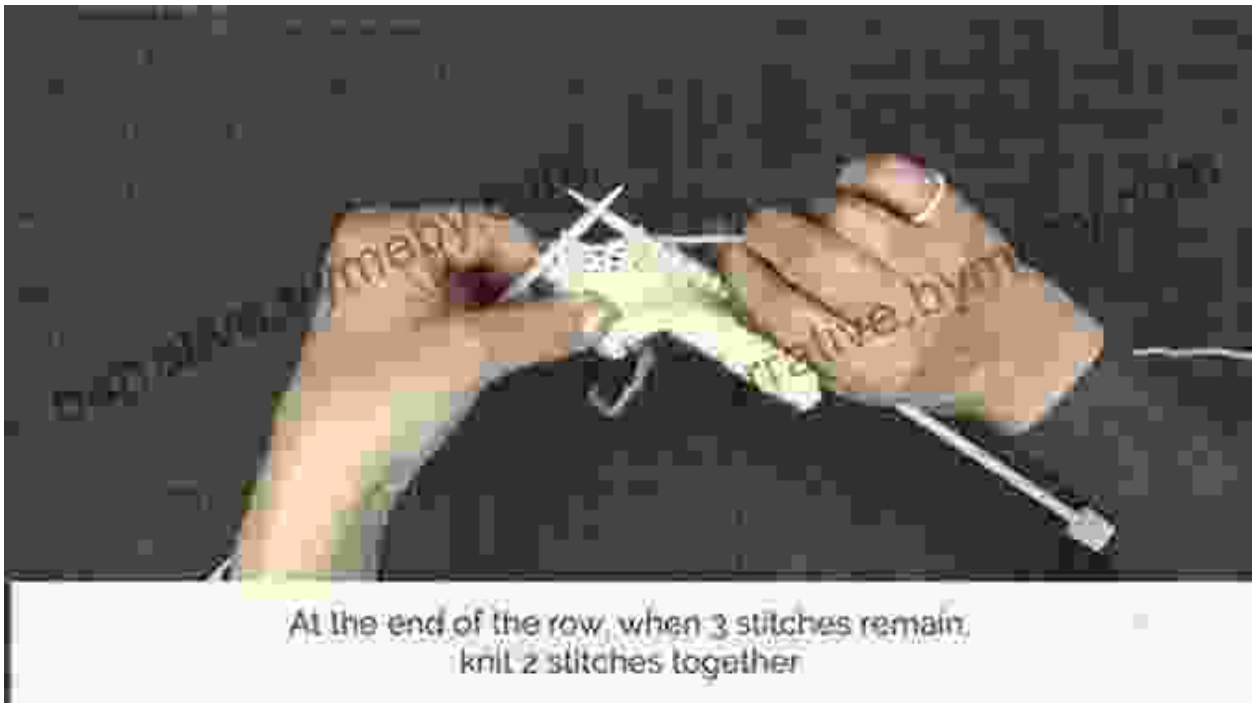
2. K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.



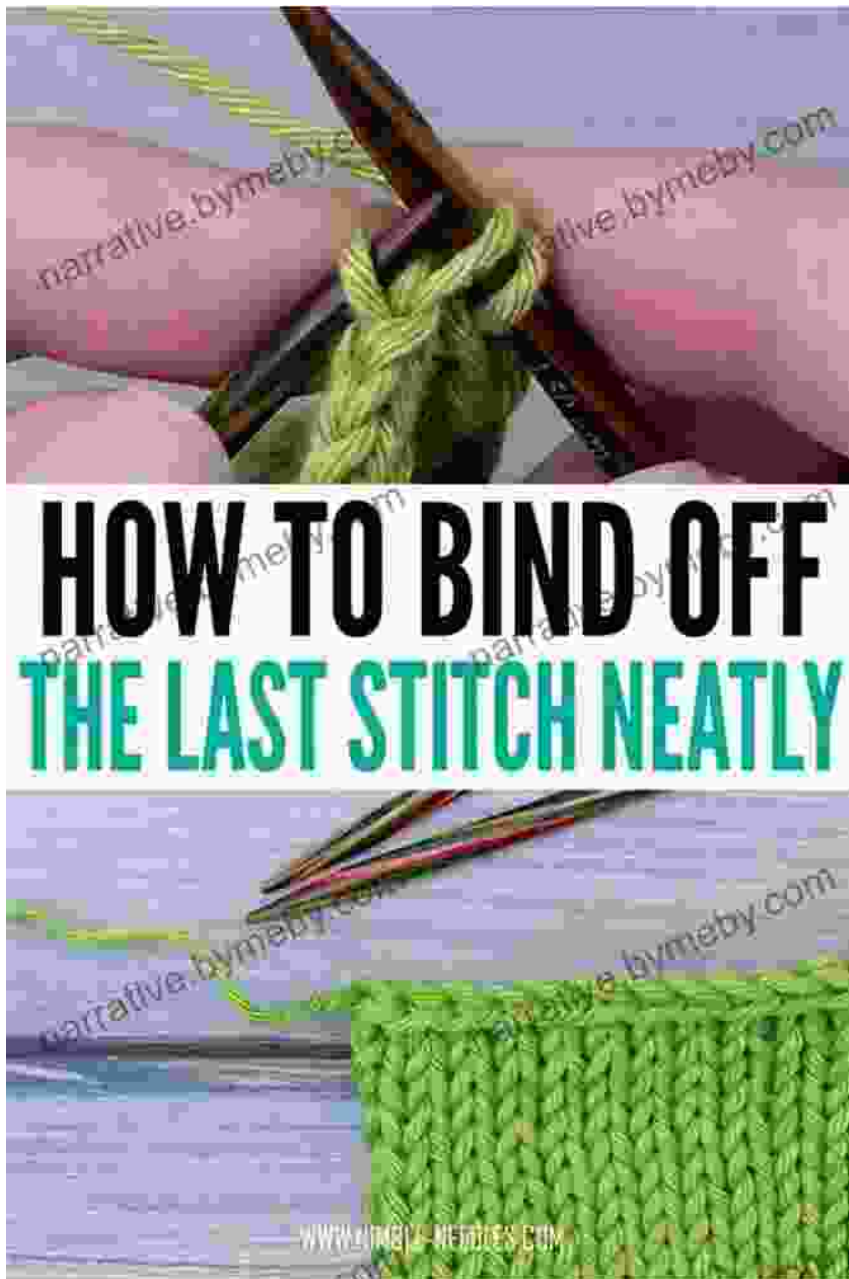
3. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 6 inches from cast on edge.



4. Shape crown: Dec 1 st at the beginning of every other row until only 8 sts remain.



5. Bind off remaining sts.



Trousers

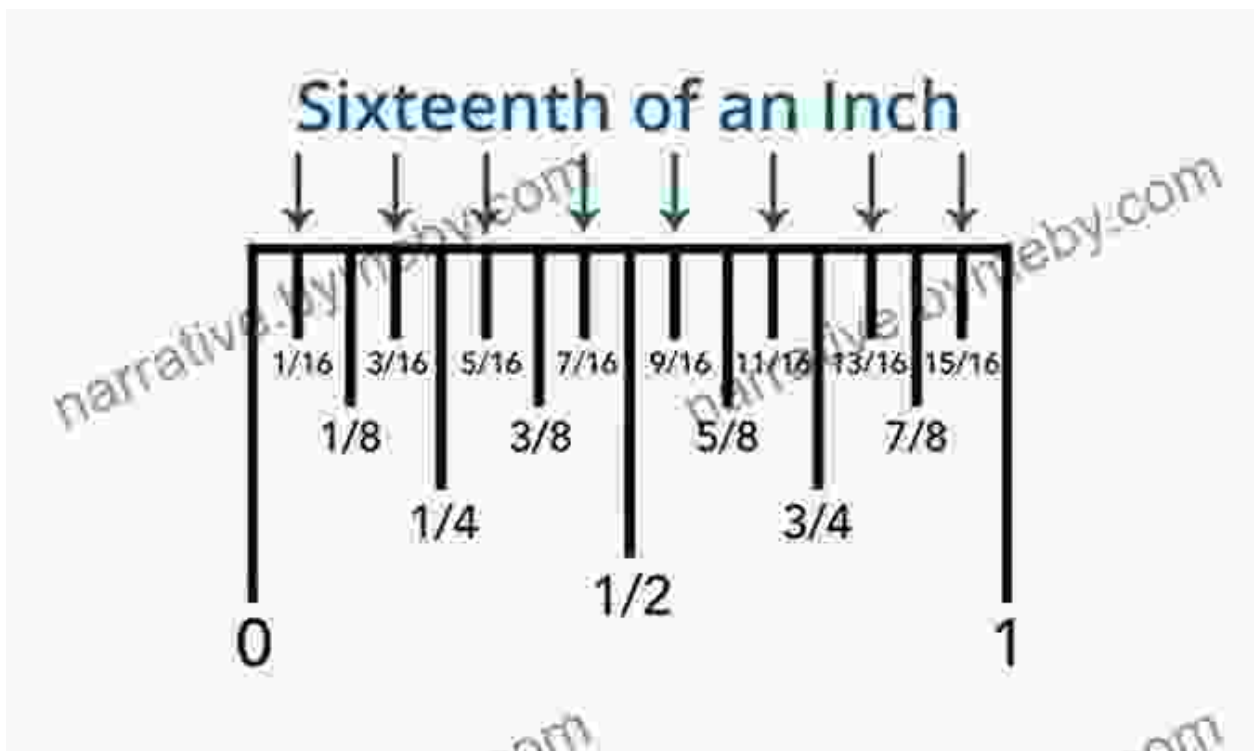
1. Co 60 sts.



2. K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.



3. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 6 inches from cast on edge.



4. Shape legs: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.



5. Continue knitting until piece measures 12 inches from cast on edge.



6. Shape crotch: Bind off 15 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.



7. Continue knitting until piece measures 16 inches from cast on edge.



8. Shape waist: Bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.



9. Bind off remaining sts.



Finishing

Once all of the pieces are knit, you can sew them together to create the jacket, hat, and trousers. The jacket has a button closure at the front, and the hat and trousers have an elastic waistband.

This baby matinee jacket, hat, and trousers set is a beautiful and practical gift for any new baby. The pattern is easy to follow and the finished

products are sure to be cherished for years to come.



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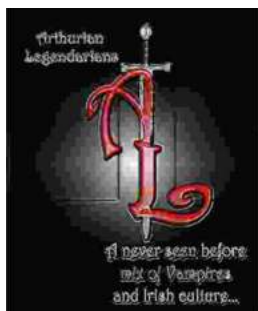
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
