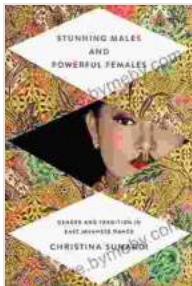

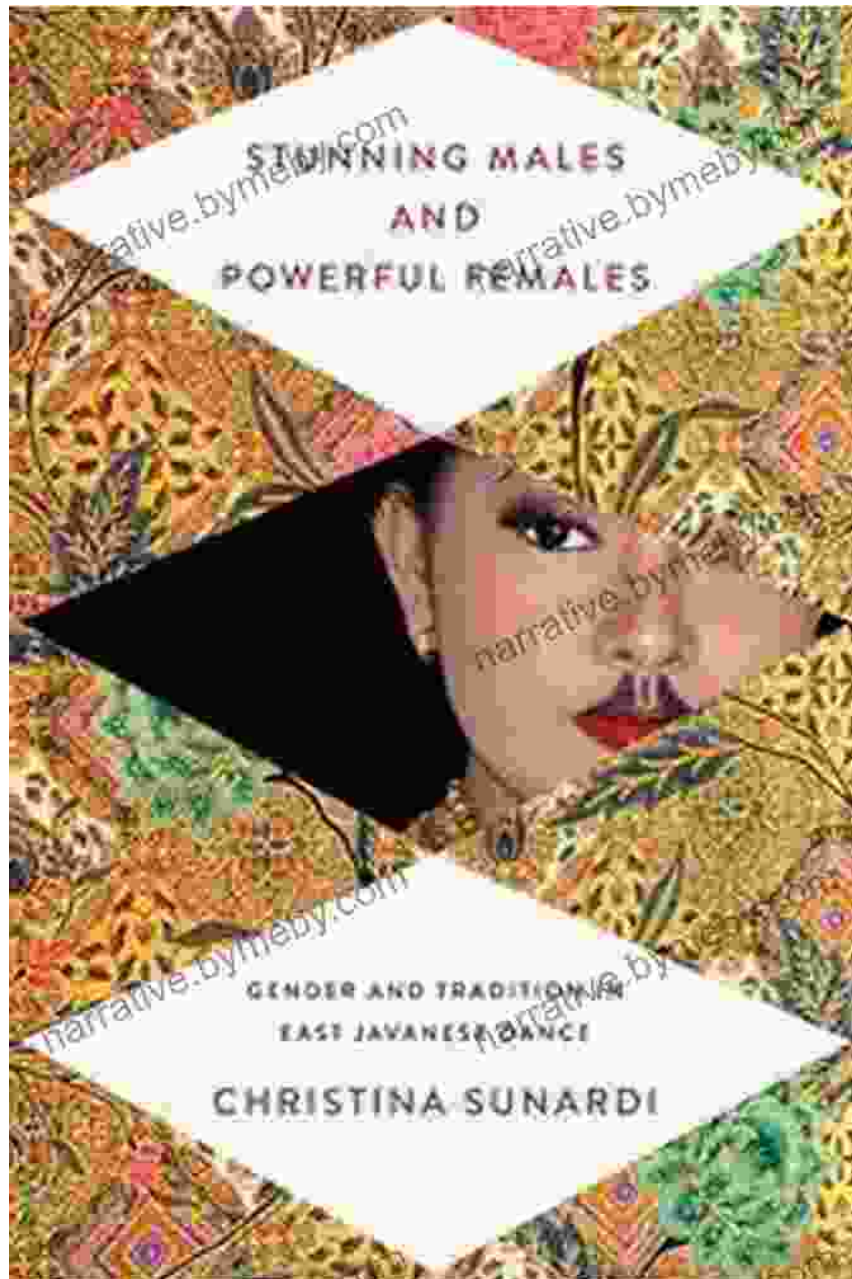

Thomas hesitated for a moment, then he smiled.

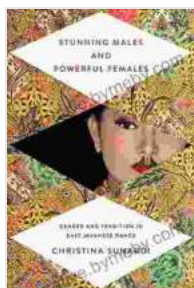
"I would be honored, my lady."
