1: The size of a panel should be based off of how long you want the reader to look at said panel. That's why scenery panels are often oblong.




2: Try to plot out speech bubbles before you draw in the characters. **AVOID** having a speech bubble in front of someone's face!




3: Try to avoid having heavy amounts of zoom in panels. Aim to get the **ENTIRE** character in the frame as much as possible. It challenges you as an artist and opens up room for interesting angles.



4: Create a "Flow" with your panels. This is where thumbnailing the entire story comes in handy. Small boxes with stick figures even helps.



4a: The characters inside the panels can have a sense of "flow" too. You can use the characters to move the readers eye to the next panel. You don't need this in every panel though.

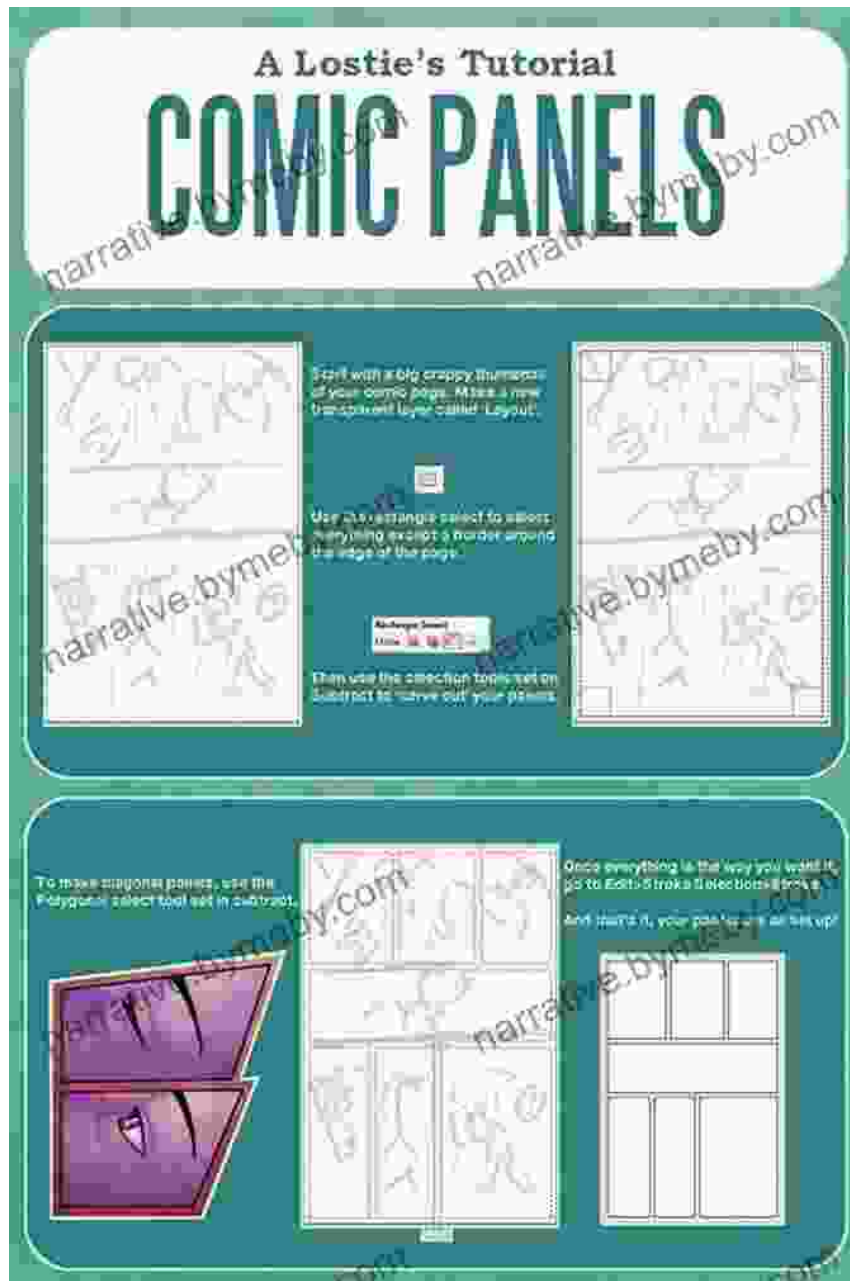

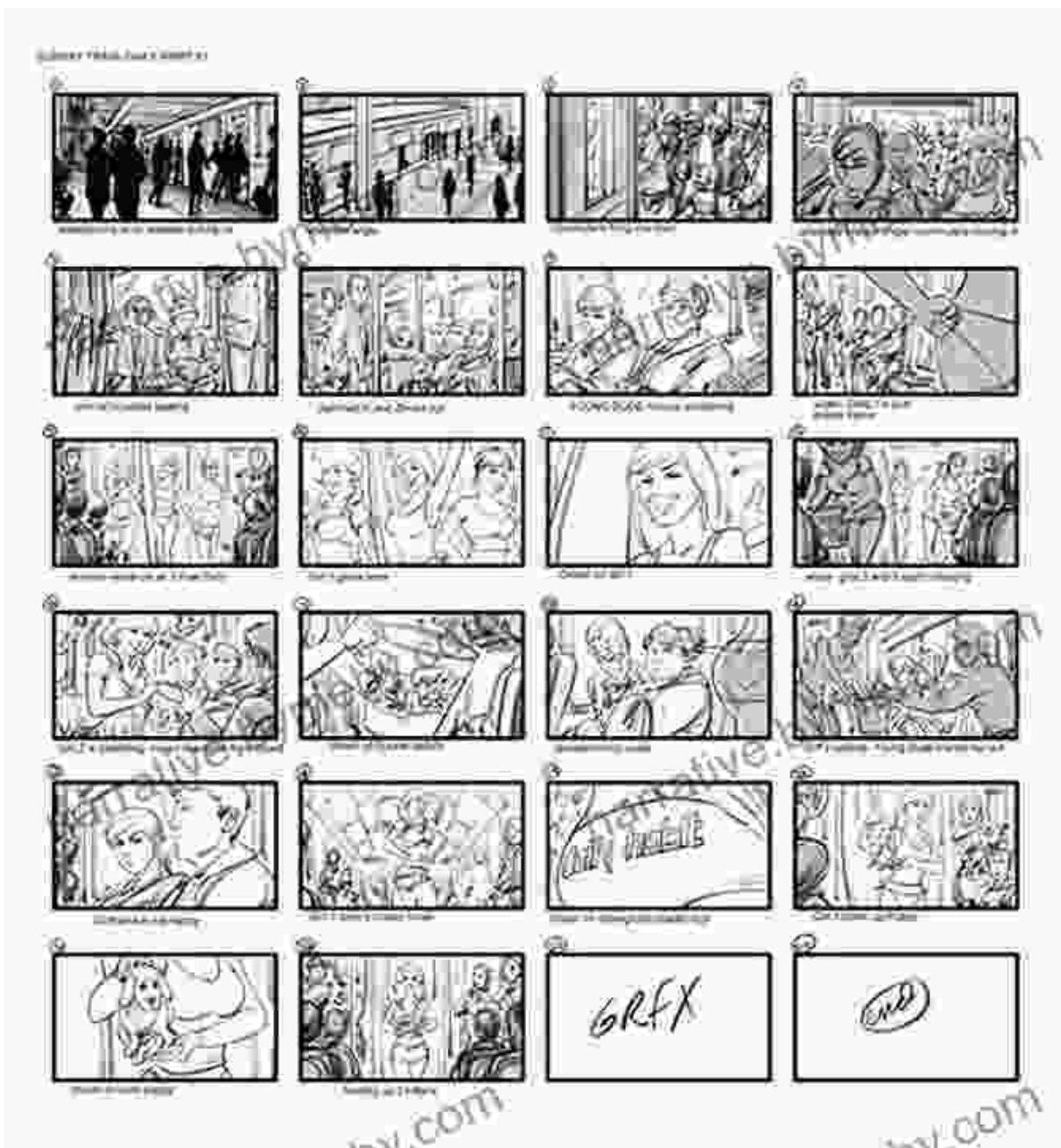

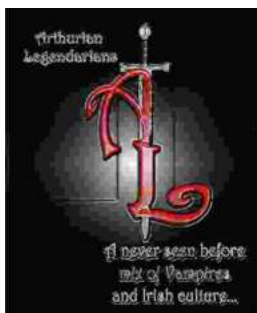
